The 9 Best US Resorts for Pod Travel

Timbers Kauai, Lihue, Hawaii

While the sprawling resort and residences at Timbers Kauai were not actually built for a pandemic, they might as well have been. Spread across 450 oceanfront acres on the southeast coast of Kauai, the property is home to 17 miles of hiking trails, the only Jack Nicklaus course on the island, and an ever-expanding farm that supports the dining, bar, and spa programs with fresh ingredients. Timbers has only 40 accommodations in total, which would make for a private feel in any circumstances, but each of these is in fact its own residence with two to four bedrooms, fully stocked kitchens, large living rooms, oceanfront or ocean-view lanais, and in-unit washers and dryers. While any of the resort's three residence styles would be great for group travel, the three- and four-bedroom Laola townhomes are especially ideal, with their bi-level layout, private outdoor area and plunge pool, ample dining space, and breathtaking views.
