



10 Top-Rated Resorts in Vail, CO

Vail is one of [Colorado's most legendary ski resorts](#), known for swanky accommodations, a celebrity scene, and a Bavarian village vibe. Located just off I-70, about 2.5 hours west of Denver, Vail skews towards the luxury market, with most resorts garnering the 4-star and 5-star demographic. These cater to families and couples alike, and many of the best resorts are also dog friendly!

A year-round resort, Vail is just as popular in summer as in winter. It is also easy to get around, with gondolas and chairlifts running right down into its two main car-free villages, **Vail Village** and **Lionshead**, as well as points to the east and west. Free shuttle buses also connect resorts with the villages.

A trendy boutique property, The Sebastian - Vail is also **located in the middle of the action at Vail Village**. With a fantastic art collection and a cozy library, the public spaces here are designed for living and appreciating.

Rooms and suites come in a variety of shapes and sizes, ranging from single queen beds to four-bedroom residential-style suites that are **perfect for large families or groups of friends**. All are comfy chic and come with high-quality linens and nightly turndown service

The spa here is very good. Besides the usual range of massages, facials and body scrubs, it offers **oxygen treatments** if you are feeling the altitude. Other amenities include a year-round heated swimming pool and several hot tubs plus a fitness center.

Grab a bite to eat at the mountain bistro-inspired restaurant Leonora, which serves locally sourced organic fare that changes with the seasons. You can also order room service.
